Losing a child is not a topic many are comfortable discussing. However, having witnessed several friends experience this devastation, I can confirm they love to keep their babies in the conversation. A few years ago, a friend told me about Rock Goodbye Angel, a non-profit organization created by Angela Ewers that helped her through the darkest times. Rock Goodbye Angel offers a support system and peer network for bereaved families and brings awareness to local communities. RGA affirms that even though these families lost their babies, no one can take away the title of "mom," "dad," "sibling," or "grandparent." They believe that these babies were created for a higher purpose.

On Saturday, November 9th, my daughter Persephone, my fellow **King GREEN** employee Tabitha Coker and I participated in the Pink & Blue Dash 5K put on by RGA in Gainesville, GA. We were there to support our friends who have experienced infant loss and let them know their babies are not forgotten. Before the 5k kicked off, we had a moment of silence where everyone blew bubbles. Standing there surrounded by others who were missing a part of their family was humbling. Through all the huffing, puffing and complaining about my calves hurting, it was worth it. It took us one hour and seventeen minutes to walk 3.1 miles. While I may have only finished 211th out of 223 participants, I am thankful for the opportunity to walk in memory of these angel babies. I am also thankful that my 7-year-old daughter was able to walk alongside me. I will definitely participate in this 5K again in 2020. If you or anyone you know has suffered the loss of a child, I encourage you to get in touch with Rock Goodbye Angel and/or consider supporting this organization to assist other bereaved families.



Today, we applied our winter (Round 8) application to your lawn. Cool-season lawns received a pre-emergent application for poa annua. This application will help reduce the poa population in the lawn and allow your newly seeded fescue room to thrive.



Bermuda and zoysia lawns both received a limestone treatment. Limestone helps condition the soil, which allows your lawn to use fertilizers more efficiently. If you have any questions, please call our office. We'll be glad to help in any way.

### DID YOU RECEIVE A TREE AND SHRUB APPLICATION TODAY?

The tree and shrub application today consisted of fertilization for your valuable landscape plants. We applied a controlled-release fertilizer to your trees and shrubs to provide nutrients throughout the year and promote an active root system. This fertilizer application will strengthen your trees and shrubs as they go into the winter season. Plus, it will promote better blooming and enhanced vitality next spring.

## Birds in Your Garden: How to Get and Keep Them

Birds add beauty and interest to even the smallest yard. Birds of many species will return year after year to the same location if you provide a constant supply of water, food, and protected nesting sites. Especially in winter, their bright colors can add a welcome change during periods of dreary weather.

Begin filling your feeding stations before the natural food supplies are gone. Different feeders attract different kinds of birds, from the simple seed bell to hopper feeders that let smaller birds perch while feeding. Platform feeders are good for larger birds, like jays, while tube feeders are good for finches. The type of food you use will also determine the birds that come. Suet (hard, white fat) feeders, for instance, attract insect-eaters like woodpeckers, chickadees and nuthatches. When feeders are placed near bushes, the birds have a place to perch and preen in the winter sun.

Locate your feeding stations where you can get to them easily and keep a supply of water close at hand. Birds are creatures of habit. Once you begin feeding them, it's very important that you continue throughout the winter. They'll be depending on you!
